everal growing trends are converging on the cabinet hardware industry at once. Universal Design, wellness, nature-inspired style, gold and black finishes – and, of course, the desire for beautiful, functional spaces - are all impacting the products entering the marketplace.

For those who are concerned about aging-in-place, as well as germs and cleanliness, there is a significant influx of decorative hardware pieces that deliver an ergonomic design and even have natural or added antimicrobial properties. A desire to make the home a refuge has led to a renewed interest in natural materials and designs, and the decorative hardware market does not disappoint, delivering forest- and seaside-inspired style as well as more organic textures and materials. In addition, the silver tones continue to yield to more unexpected options, including blacks and off blacks – especially matte – and golds in every variation from silvery to rosy to antique.

Not to be outdone, the design of functional hardware has been stepped up a notch, with slow-close and quiet-close hinges and drawer slides getting improvements in operation, wear and tear and






