## INSTALLATION INFORMATION

Most people know that cabinets should be installed after painting and before appliances, countertops, and tile work. But whenever possible, they should also be installed after flooring, so that if you (or a future homeowner) decide to tear out or reconfigure the cabinets, the flooring will go all the way to the wall. If timing becomes an issue, it's acceptable to install cabinets first, but not preferred. When it comes to installation, most designers and manufacturers recommend working with an experienced contractor in order to avoid costly mistakes. "We have a list of trusted installers we've built over the last 10 years, and we recommend it to everyone starting a project, big or small," says John McDonald, CEO of cabinetmaker Semihandmade and BOXI by Semihandmade.
